What is ABA, in plain terms?

ABA stands for Applied Behavior Analysis. It's a well-studied, widely recommended approach that helps children build everyday skills, one small, encouraging step at a time. We look closely at what your child already does well and what motivates them, then use that to teach new skills through play and daily routines. Most of all, it meets your child where they are, in the place they're most comfortable: home.

WHAT ABA CAN HELP WITH

- Communication and language
- Play and social skills with others
- Getting ready for school
- Daily routines: dressing, mealtimes, sleep
- Easing behaviors that get in the way
- Growing confidence and independence

WHAT A SESSION ACTUALLY LOOKS LIKE

In your home. We come to you, so your child learns where they live and play.

Play-based and one-on-one. We follow your child's lead and keep it positive.

Measured, not guesswork. We track progress and adjust as your child grows.

You're on the team. We coach you too, so progress continues between visits.

WHO GUIDES YOUR CHILD'S CARE

Every program is designed and overseen by a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) — a nationally certified clinician trained specifically in this work. At Cove ABA that's Evan, our founder, who stays personally involved in every family we serve.

Questions families ask us

Is my child a good fit?

If your child is on the autism spectrum, from early intervention age through school age, they likely are. The best first step is a conversation. We'll tell you honestly if we're not the right fit.

Who actually comes to our home?

A trained therapist works directly with your child, guided by a plan our BCBA designs and oversees. Because we keep caseloads small, you see familiar faces, not a rotating cast.

How much time does it take?

It depends on your child's needs and goals. We'll recommend a schedule that fits your family's life, and revisit it together as things change.

Does insurance cover it?

Usually, yes. We're in-network with a range of NY plans including NYS Medicaid — the current list is at coveaba.com/insurance — and we handle the insurance and authorization paperwork for you.

What's expected of me as a parent?

Your involvement matters, and we make it manageable. We coach you along the way so the progress your child makes with us carries into everyday life.
